Somebody has (eat) all the donuts.

I have (forget) my password.

I have (drink) too many cans of Red Bull.

My coworker hasn't (speak) to me since I told her I was an atheist.

I have (lose) my glasses.

Somebody has (take) my chair.

My colleagues have all (go) home sick.

The cleaners have (move) all the desks.

I have (read) this email three times, but I still don't understand it.

The designer still hasn't (make) a decision about the font size.

My colleague has (bring) her smelly dog to the office.

I lent my colleague €20 last week and he still hasn't (pay) me back.

I have (tell) her a hundred times she should turn her computer off after work.

We haven't (see) our manager since she started

Do these problems relate to a <u>specific</u> or <u>unspecific</u> time.

Is the problem current or is it a story about the past?
